What is the Winners' Circle Competition?

As a chapter of Sweet Adelines International, Spirit of the Gulf Chorus has a mission of encouraging the development of young women harmony singers. The Winners' Circle allows students to audition for the opportunity to perform on our annual show (March 20, 2010) and compete for cash prizes.

Who can participate?

We are seeking promising female singers, 25 years of age or younger, who can sing harmony in a duet, trio, or quartet.

How are the auditions structured?

Auditions are scheduled in Fort Myers. The first 20 groups that call will be scheduled CALL 239- 218-2999 TO SCHEDULE. Experienced musicians from the chorus will serve as judges and will evaluate the total package: singing, expression, and showmanship. Groups can sing a cappella or with a CD track.

The Finals

Groups who qualify for the finals will be informed, and will perform on the first half of the "Winners' Circle" show on March 20, 2010 at the First Christian Church of Fort Myers. Cash prizes will be awarded to the first three places. \$800 for first, \$400 for second, and \$200 for third.
